Job Description: Sexton

The Sexton facilitates gathering and fellowship of the congregation through set-up and clean-up.

Hours & Expectations:

- Up to 4 hours/week on Sunday mornings (8:30 a.m. -12:30 p.m.) plus up to 4 additional hours per month for planning and supervision.
- Additional hours for special events such as memorial services, weddings, or other special events as mutually agreeable.
- If there is interest, this work could be combined with cleaning for a more substantial position.

Pay Rate: \$20/hour

Reporting Relationship: Reports to the Pastor.

Essential Functions:

1. Work with staff and volunteers to move furniture as needed in the sanctuary and throughout the building.
2. Prepare kitchen and serving areas for food and drink service; clean up the kitchen and serving areas afterwards.
3. Check the building for any obvious small clean-up needs and address them.

Core Competencies:

1. Reliable and attentive to detail.
2. Capable of comfortably moving chairs, tables, and other items around the church.
3. Welcoming, positive, and sensitive to a variety of abilities and needs when communicating.
4. Respectful of all community members, including folks of diverse identities and expressions (gender, race, culture, sexuality, ability, and more).
5. Independent and collaborative worker.
